- Maintain the Town's open space/agriculture
- Maintain/enhance recreational resources
- Upgrade/expand infrastructure networks

- Top area's for Town improvement over the next 10 years:
 - Parks + recreational amenities
 - Infrastructure improvements
 - Economic / business development



OPEN SPACE



- Most respondents (67%) would like the Town to take additional action to protect open space in the Town.
- Locations for open space preservation:
 - Ayrault Rd / Turk Hill Rd
 - Erie Canal
 - Whitney Road
 - Northeast / Southeast Quadrants

- Top historic and cultural resources that should be maintained over the next 10 years:
 - Erie Canal
 - Town hamlets / historic districts
 - Historic building / landmarks

HOUSING CHOICES / OPTIONS

- Many respondents believe housing options within the Town serve the needs of existing residents and help to attract new residents.
- Approximately 30% of respondents believe the Town has sufficient senior housing options.

- Top housing development choices for the Town over the next 10 years:
 - Single-family homes
 - Affordable / Subsidized housing
 - Mixed-use developments
 - Townhomes

- Top commercial development choices for the Town over the next 10 years:
 - Restaurants / Bars
 - Retail
 - Indoor Recreational Centers
- Many respondents would like to see increased mixed-use development in Bushnell's Basin.
- Many respondents see the need for increased small-scale commercial development throughout the Town

RECREATION + PARKS



RECREATIONAL PROGRAMS



- Most respondents are very satisfied with recreation and park services provided by the Town.
- Most respondents do not think additional recreational programs are needed over the next 10 years.
- Residents who utilize the Senior 55+ Program are very satisfied with the services offered.



TOWN COMMUNITY CENTER USAGE



- The most utilized recreational facilities within the Town include:
 - Aquatic Center
 - Indoor Track
 - Fitness Center



PARK AND TRAIL USAGE



- The majority of respondents utilize parks and trails within the Town at least once per week.
- Most respondents engage in the following activities most often:
 - Walking / running
 - Hiking
 - Biking



PARK AND TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS



- Top desired recreational improvements:
 - Expanded trail system
 - Additional Erie canal access
 - Expanded sidewalk network
 - Passive open green space
- Many respondents would like to see additional parks developed and enhanced connections between park spaces.



PARK AND TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS



- Many respondents would like to see additional amenities within parks:
 - Lighting
 - Water Stations
 - Benches / Seating opportunities



ERIE CANAL ACCESS



- Most respondents (67%) believe access to the Erie Canal is limited.
- Most respondents would like to maintain open space / vegetation along the Erie Canal.

TRANSPORTATION



TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS



- Approximately 45% of respondents said there are no issues with the Town's existing transportation system.
- Identified areas for improvement:
 - Turk Hill Rd / Route 31
 - Route 250
 - Additional sidewalks / bicycle facilities throughout the Town

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

- Approximately 49% of respondents believe that public transportation is not easily accessible.
- Approximately 83% of respondents said they *wouldn't* use public transportation, even if there were more options.
- Opportunities for routes/stops:
 - Route 250 / 31
 - Town Community Center
 - Village of Fairport

OTHER TOPIC AREAS



- Majority of respondents are satisfied with the environmental and sustainability efforts of the Town.
- Most respondents believe the positives of the landfill outweigh the negatives.
- Majority of respondents said they have little to no concern in the Town regarding public safety.
